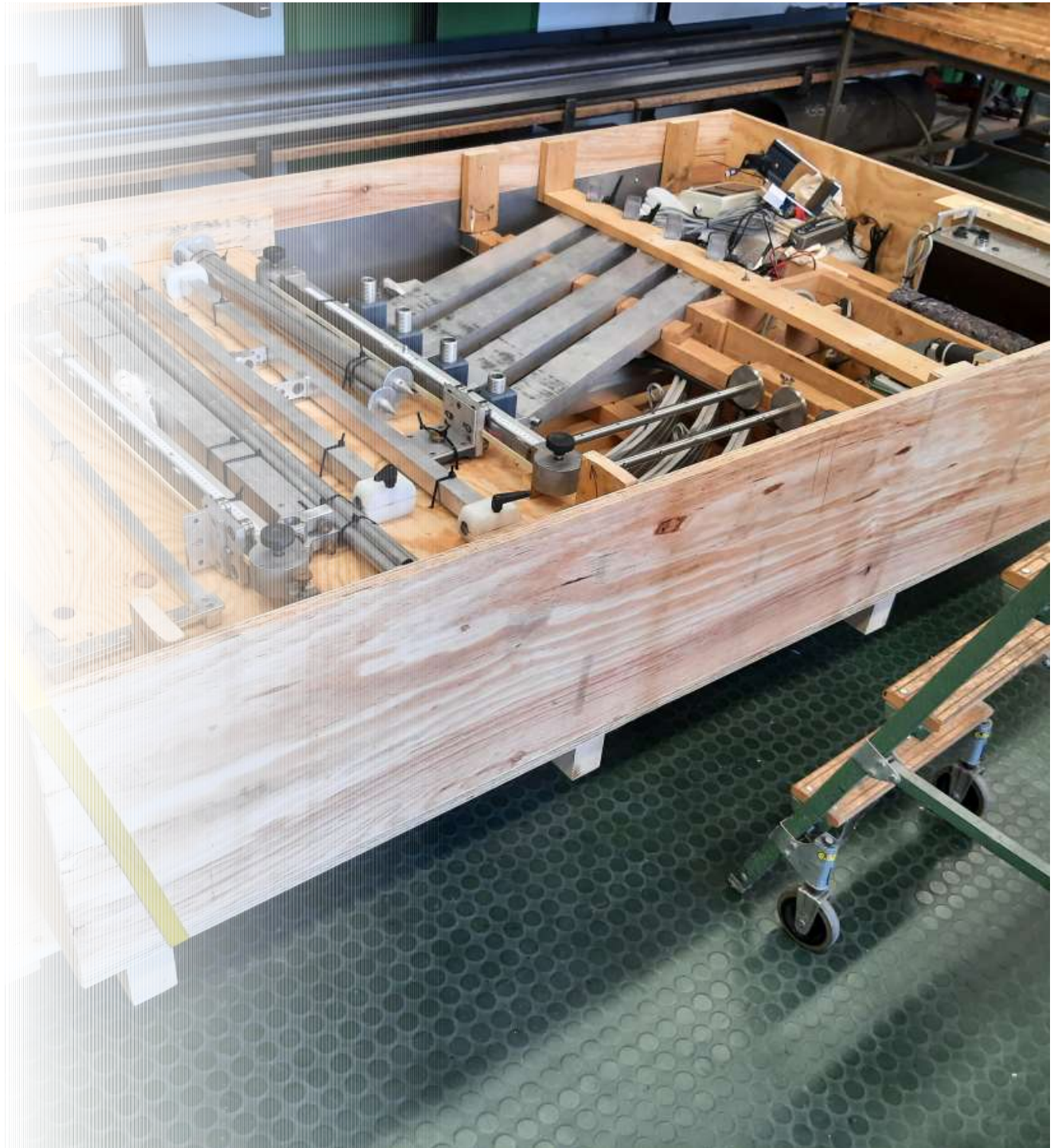

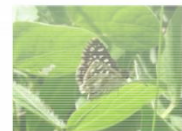

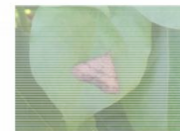

 - Alpha diversity of organisms



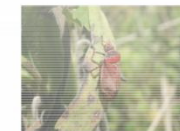

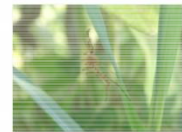

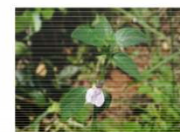
