Databases **during** the Workshop

Databases **after** the Workshop

- You may add, modify and delete datasets in the training databases ad libitum.

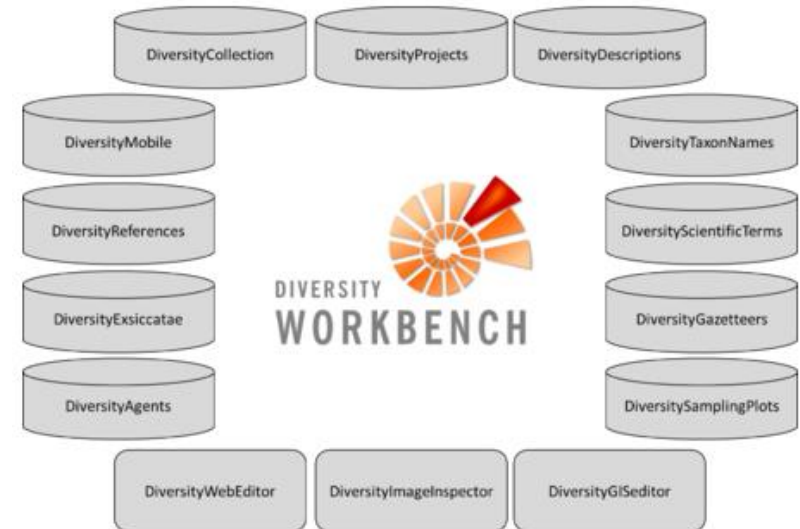
